

# Download 2001 Audi A4 Quattro B5 Owners Manual

The second generation S4 (Type 8D), now correctly titled Audi S4 quattro debuted in 1997, with factory production commencing October 1997, as part of the facelifted B5 platform Audi A4 line-up, although it wasn't available in North America until late 1999. The original B5 Audi RS4 Avant quattro (Typ 8D) was introduced by Audi in late 1999, for main production and sale from 2000, as the successor to the Porsche / quattro GmbH joint venture-developed Audi RS2 Avant. Alright, I apologize if this has already been asked...and I know I've seen SEVERAL other posts of people trying to turbo their 2.8L v6, and how others hate on us 2.8 owners and say we should've gone with a 1.8T....But I'd like to do something different. Well mine is running excellently at 141,000+ miles and I plan on having it for a lot longer. Although I only bought it about 10,000 miles ago, I can tell the previous owners took excellent care of the car and except for a few minor dings on the rear bumper, it is in perfect running order.
