The Pictorial History series from Ian Allan was highly illustrated series of books covering a wide range of civil and military aviation subjects. Air Historical Branch RAF has opened up its photo archive for this book and what a treasure trove it is. The colour images of transport aircraft are particularly attractive, for example the Argosy formation on the back cover and the pristine Britannia on the front. My personal favourite is on page 80. This is the first of a new 'Pictorial History' series and can be warmly welcomed. Between the wars the RAF, having taken over control of all aviation, had special responsibilities to the Army, such as air reconnaissance, artillery spotting and exercising anti-aircraft units. But when an Expeditionary Force went to France in 1939 the RAF, although a separate Service, was still dependent upon the Army for base, signals and other essential facilities.
