House mice are not usually a vector of human plague (bubonic plague) because they have fewer infestations with fleas than do rats, and because the fleas which house mice normally carry exhibit little tendency to bite humans rather than their natural host. A house mouse will rarely live more than a year in the wild, but in a protected environment with food and water (such as a house), it can live up to three years.
