Applied psychology is the use of psychological methods and findings of scientific psychology to solve practical problems of human and animal behavior and experience. Usually, the degrees associated with clinical psychology are the traditional Ph.D. (Doctor of Philosophy) —which involves training in both clinical treatment and research—and the newer Psy.D. (Doctor of Psychology)—which emphasizes clinical training and minimizes training in research.
